Description of Additional Services:

As part of the ongoing effort to complete the required NPC evaluations to submit to HCAI by January 1, 2024, Devenney Group Ltd., Architects (DGL) and our consultants will provide additional design services that includes the options listed below for the Mendocino Coast District Hospital Campus (MCDHC):

The requirements for nonstructural (NPC) inventory reports are outlined in 2022 CAC Chapter 6 Section 1.3.4. Based on communication with HCAI about specific expectations and experience with similar reports, the following items will be included as applicable within each option listed:

- 1. Identification of functional areas and spaces for each floor, including which areas are subject to NPC-3 requirements.
- 2. Inventory Table of all qualifying architectural, mechanical, electrical systems, components and equipment including room, weight, dimensions, location (on floor, walls, or counters etc.) and status (OSHPD approved, OSA approved, calculation provided etc.). The table will identify whether each component is NPC compliant or not. Examples of components and equipment include:
 - a. Storage racks, floor supported cabinets more than 5' in height
 - b. Suspended lights and ceiling fixtures
 - c. Wall hung cabinets and storage shelving.
 - d. Tanks and vessels
 - e. Electrical, Mechanical, and Plumbing Equipment
 - f. Medical equipment such as surgical lights, radiology equipment, food service equipment, laboratory equipment, tv supports.
 - g. Elevators
- Identification of qualifying overhead pipes, ducts, and conduits in inventory table by department (routes need not be shown on plans). The table will identify whether each system is NPC compliant or not.
- 4. Identification of abandoned items (which are still required to be anchored or braced if present after 2030)
