Re: Seismic Compliance Team Report

The Seismic Compliance Team convened meetings in early June to discuss planning efforts and communication regarding the seismic compliance project and a potential bond measure to help fund the project.

EMC Research joined the committee and shared a draft tracking poll that to assess community support for a potential bond measure to help fund the seismic compliance project at the MCHCD hospital. After much discussion and review of the Five-Year Capital Structure with Projected Cash Flow analysis, the board member representatives on the committee decided they would not recommend moving forward with a tracking poll for a potential measure.

The Seismic Compliance Team activity is suspended until further notice. The need for ongoing communication and outreach to the community continues, however, and Props and Measures is available to continue working with the District in these efforts.
